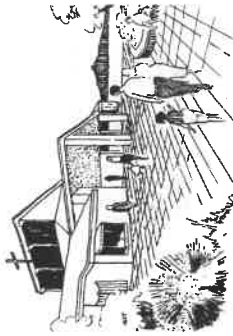

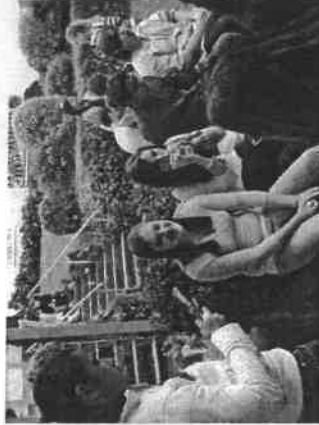

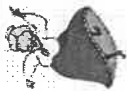
Parish Council A.G.M. and celebration of the end of the Year of the Eucharist **Sunday 30 Oct** - after 10 am Mass
